Central University of Haryana was established vide Central Universities Act, 2009 of the Parliament. About the Webinar


A single regulator for higher education institutions, multiple entry and exit options in degree courses, discontinuation of M.Phil. programme, low stakes board exams, common entrance exams for universities are among the highlights of the new National Education Policy-2020. Education Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' observed that New Education Policy-2020 will prove to be a milestone in the making of New India. NEP-2020 aims to increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education including vocational education from 26.30 percent to 50 percent by 2035. The policy envisages broad based, multi-disciplinary, holistic Undergraduate education with flexible curricula, creative combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education and multiple entry and exit points with appropriate certification. Under Graduate education can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit options and appropriate certification within this period. affiliation of colleges is to be phased out in 15 years and a stage-wise mechanism is to be established for granting graded autonomy to colleges. Over a period of time, it is envisaged that every college would develop into either an autonomous degree-granting college, or a constituent college of a university. Among the

key reforms in the policy are- a single regulator for all higher education institutions except for legal and medical colleges, common entrance exam for admissions to universities and colleges to be conducted by the National Testing Agency and common norms to be in place for private and public higher education institutions. In this historical change, the role of teacher becomes very crucial. Thus, the Webinar highlights the role of teacher and teacher education in the process of desired transformations in the education system towards a More Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education.

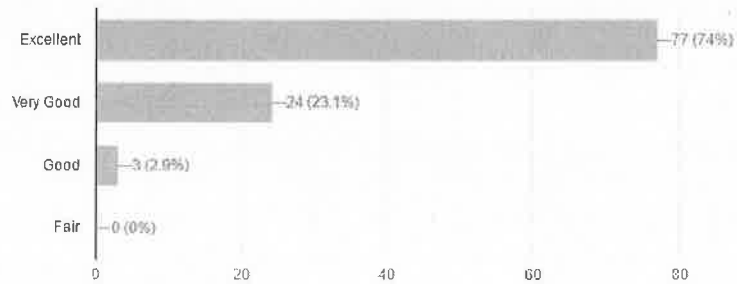

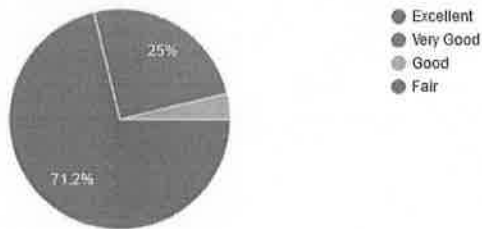
How did you find the content of the todays' session of the training?

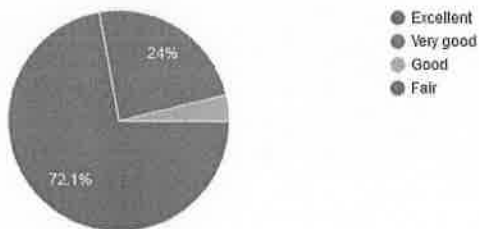

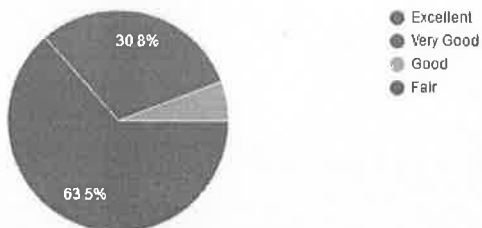
