where,
 M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this GATE 2018 scorecard
 M_q is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper
 M_c is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)
 S_q = 350, is the score assigned to M_q
 S_c = 900, is the score assigned to M_c
 In the GATE 2018 score formula, M_q is 25 marks (out of 100) or μ + σ, whichever is greater. Here μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared in the paper.
