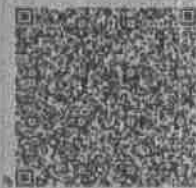

- Qualifying the CTET would not confer a right to be appointed for recruitment/apPOINTment, it is only one of the eligibility criteria of appointment.
- The eligibility of the candidate cannot be verified by the Board. The particulars of the candidate and the subject offered by him/her are as per the declaration in the Application Form of CTET. The Recruiting Authority may verify the same before appointment.
- (The CTET shall apply to all schools of the Central Government (DCE, NCE, Central Tibetan Schools, etc.) and Schools under the administrative control of UTs of Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Diu and Daman and Diu and Andaman & Nicobar Islands and NCT of Delhi. (NCTET may also apply to the unaided private Schools, who may opt for the option of conducting the CTET.)
- All State Government can also conduct the CTET if it decides not to conduct the State TET.
